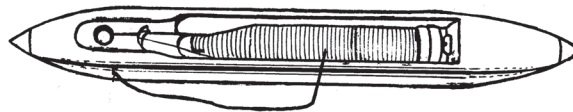
Monthly Meeting -- 10 AM

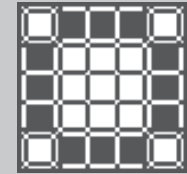
