Weaving Workshop

Pauline Verbeck-Cowart will be giving a workshop on collapsed fabrics at The Yarn Barn in Lawrence, KS on April 28-29. Pauline is an associate professor at the Kansas City Art Institute. Explore texture through weave structure and surface manipulation. Emphasis will be on combining structural patterns with surface applications, which take hand-woven beyond the capabilities of the loom. You will make numerous woven samples showing different structures and yarn combinations. The resulting fabric will have permanent pleats, puckers, and layered depth to create an exciting dimensional quality. Skill level is intermediate. Class fee is \$150.00.
