

## Weavers Guild of Greater Kansas City Educational Scholarship

Beginners as well as advanced fiber artists may apply. Financial need is not a consideration.

**Amount of award:** Will depend on Guild funds and class cost.

**Purpose:** To enrich the applicant's personal growth in the fiber field, as well as cultivate the Guild community and knowledge of the fiber arts.

**Eligibility:** All Guild members in good standing, who have been a member for one year.

**Deadline for submission:** Reviewed quarterly: January, April, July, & October meetings.

### Guidelines:

1. Qualifying courses include day and multi-day workshops. Applications to attend workshops must be accompanied by a brochure or other appropriate material describing the event.
2. Application form may be obtained from the Scholarship Committee Chairperson (or printed from the Guild Website). The application must be typed, computer generated or legibly printed. Neatness counts. Committee must be able to read what you present.
3. If the event for which the scholarship money was received is cancelled, the recipient must return the money to the Guild as soon as possible or no later than 60 days after cancellation.
4. Recipient must make a presentation to the Guild within one year after the completion of the study. (*In some rare cases the program may be scheduled after one year has elapsed in order to meet the needs of the Guild Program Schedule.*) This will be in the form of a program (lecture or hands-on) following a regular Guild meeting. Recipients of more than \$250.00 or more are expected to give a mini-workshop as well as a presentation. All presentations should include a handout.
5. Previous award recipients who received \$100.00 or more may re-apply for another scholarship only after a *three-year period* from date of previous scholarship event. Previous award recipients who received less than \$100.00 may re-apply for another scholarship after a *two-year period* from date of previous scholarship event.
6. Applications will be reviewed quarterly by the Scholarship Committee. The committee will forward award recommendations to the Guild Board for final approval. Proposals not accepted during any given year may be re-submitted the following year.

**Educational Scholarship Application**

Scholarship recipients are required to present a program (*and possibly a mini-workshop depending on the award amount*) to the Weavers Guild of Greater Kansas City within **one** year (or as soon thereafter as the Guild schedule allows) of completion of the study. The presentation(s) should be arranged through the Guild Program Chair. The aim of the presentation is to teach something that the recipient learned in the course of study. Presentation should last at least 45 minutes.
